

CSS Transitions

In general, CSS transitions are smoother than JS-driven animations, but not as much as you'd think. To animate this box getting wider, a CSS transition still must re-render the element for each frame of the animation, meaning it must re-calculate its dimensions and those of its descendants *and* re-flow the text.

Let's morph back to a narrow box so you can see this in action again.

```
$('#panel').morph('width: 300px');
```
